Dear parents/carers

After half term the year 4 children will be learning about habitats and the classification of different species of animals.

To help with this learning, we have planned to visit **The Deep** in Hull. As well as visiting the attraction and going on a tour of the environments, each class will also be taking part in workshops to classify one of The Deep's most famous animals. This is a fantastic opportunity to bring learning to life and see and classify animals as we learn about their habitats. We are also fortunate to have such a wellknown and excellent learning centre available to us.

All year 4 children will be visiting The Deep on Wednesday 28th February.

Travel

Children should be in their classroom by 8.45am on trip day, so that the bus can leave at 9.00am. We expect to be back at school by 3.30pm, so normal home time arrangements will apply.

Clothing

Children should wear their normal school uniform. The Deep has requested no high visibility vests be worn, as they can agitate the animals.

Lunch

A packed lunch is required (no glass bottles or fizzy drinks please), and a backpack to carry their lunch would also be helpful. If your child is currently receiving free school meals, they are entitled to a free packed lunch for trips. If you would like a packed lunch providing for your child, please indicate this on the form.

Payment

We are requesting voluntary contributions of **£11.00** per child to cover the cost of this trip; this includes entrance to The Deep, all activities whilst there and coach travel. There will be no other expenses, so children will not need spending money.

Payment can be made by cash or cheque or via SIMS Agora. If your child is currently receiving free school meals, or has in the past, the cost of this trip can be paid for from our Pupil Premium Fund so please indicate this on the form. Unfortunately, if insufficient contributions are received then we will be unable to run this trip.

In order to ascertain whether the trip is financially viable we are asking that consent forms and payments be sent in to school by Friday 23rd February.

This is an exciting new trip for Driffield Junior School, and we are confident that the excellent practical activities, developing the skills used in lessons, will help create a powerful and enjoyable learning experience.
