Please note: eggs must not be decorated at home prior to being brought in to school. Thanks. There will be Easter egg prizes awarded to three children in each class which will be presented in the final assembly of the term on Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> March. Good luck!



The eggs will be on display in classrooms after school on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> March for parents to view as they collect their children from school. Children will be allowed to take their eggs home on Friday.

We are sure that everyone will have a great time and we look forward to seeing how creative the children can be!

On the last day of the term, each class will go outside, one at a time, for an **'egg rolling' competition**. Egg rolling is a long standing tradition at



Easter, though I'm sure that years ago they didn't use a drainpipe as we will be doing!

Your child will need to bring a hard-boiled egg for this. They may wish to make their egg 'eggstra special' by drawing patterns on it with felt pen or paints, or they may wish to give their egg a special name which they write on decoratively.

The child in each class whose egg travels the furthest will win an Easter related prize which will be presented in our final assembly on Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> March.
