As part of our science topic, year 5 children will be investigating water resistance.

Miss Westerby has arranged for each class to visit Driffield Swimming Pool in order to experience this force first hand. A number of activities have been planned which will involve the children moving themselves and objects through water in the most and least hydrodynamic shapes. All activities will take place in the learner pool and will be supervised by a life guard.

These visits will take place during the normal school afternoons of:

The children will require their swimming costume and a towel. Long hair will need to be tied back. We will walk the children to and from the pool and will return before the end of the school day.
