Food and Farming day at Driffield Showground

Our year 6 pupils been invited to attend an exhibition at Driffield Showground on Thursday 23rd May that will encourage children to understand how science and technology helps us to produce food. Children will have the opportunity to talk to people who work in agriculture, watch demonstrations and see some animals that are reared on farms.

The event has been funded by the Driffield Agricultural Society and so is completely free. Children will be registered at school then we will walk down to the showground. Children will need to have sensible shoes for walking (no open-toed sandals) and a waterproof coat. If it is a sunny day please ensure that children have adequate sunscreen and a hat.
