Important information regarding Covid cases over the Christmas holidays

As we approach the Christmas break, it is very important that you are aware of how/when to contact school should your child receive a positive Covid test when school is not open.

Up until 24th December, if your child gets a positive Covid result and their symptoms started on or before Sunday 20th December, it is ESSENTIAL that you email me on <u>llaird@djs.eriding.net</u> as there may well be implications for children and staff in your child's bubble.

If you do need to email me, please provide the following details:

- Your child's name and class
- When your child was last in school
- The date your child's symptoms started and what the symptoms are/were
- Date of test and date positive result was confirmed
- Your name and a contact phone number I can ring you back on if necessary

I will check my emails as least once per day up to, and including, Christmas Eve.

After 24th December, you can still email me for Covid related issues (e.g. to say that your child will not be in school on 5th January due to isolation) but please don't expect an immediate response.
