FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR PARENTS

Household Support Grant Scheme

East Riding of Yorkshire Council have received funding from Government to support those most in need with the cost of food, energy (Heating, cooking, lighting), water bills (including sewerage) and other essentials over the winter months.

To be eligible for the grant, parents/guardian must be in receipt of a benefit which entitles you to free school meals

Where an applicant is successful, they will receive:

- £75.00 per household for utilities
- £20.00 per child for winter clothing where they do not have adequate winter clothing (capped at £60.00)

Many parents/guardians have already received funding from the scheme by way of a food vouchers, but we would like to advise parents they they can get help towards their bills. **Applications for the grants are open and will close 24 December 2021.**
