



# Driffield Junior School



Dear Parents/Carers

Through our work in history on invaders and settlers, year 4 have a main focus on the Vikings this term. To help support this learning and bring it to life we have booked a visit to the Jorvik Centre and DIG. While on this visit, children will travel back in time to experience York as a Viking settlement: sights, sounds and smells. They will also investigate the archaeological side of historical study, by learning about how Viking remains have been discovered, preserved, and ultimately used to piece together what life was like during the period.

The visit will take place on **Monday 18<sup>th</sup> June**; with all 5 classes going on the same day. We apologise for the short notice but we have been waiting for some information related to the visit.

## Timing

Children should be in their classroom by 8.45am on this day and we expect to be back at school by 3:30pm, so normal home time arrangements will apply.

## Clothing

Children should come in normal school uniform, with a sensible choice of shoes as we will be walking between Jorvik and DIG.

## Lunch

A packed lunch is required (no glass bottles or fizzy drinks please). A backpack to carry this lunch would also be helpful. If your child is currently receiving free school meals, they are entitled to a free packed lunch for trips. If you would like a packed lunch providing for your child, please indicate this on the form.

## Payment

There is a voluntary contribution towards the cost of this visit of £12.50 per child; this includes entrance to the museums and coach travel. Unfortunately if insufficient contributions are received then we may be unable to run this visit. If your child is currently receiving free school meals, or has in the past, the cost of this visit can be paid for from our Pupil Premium Fund so please indicate this on the form.

In order to ascertain whether this visit is financially viable we are asking that consent forms and payments be sent to school by Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> June.
